

St Paul's Primary School – Uniform

School Hat – is worn all year round. All hats MUST have a school logo on them.

Bucket or Legionnaire style ~Green with Red School Logo.

Summer Uniform - Girls

- Summer dress. Or Summer culottes
- Red polo shirt with green logo.
- White socks with black shoes or brown sandals (socks optional with sandals).
- Hair ribbons etc to be - green, red or white.

Summer Uniform - Boys

- Grey Shorts
- Red polo shirt with green logo.
- Grey socks with black shoes or brown sandals (socks optional with sandals).

Winter Uniform - Girls

- Bottle green windcheater with red logo.
- Red polo shirt (long or short sleeves) with green logo.
- Tartan skirt with pleats or slacks
- Black socks or tights with black shoes. (Black sports shoes with logos or inserted colours are not permitted)

Winter Uniform - Boys

- Bottle green windcheater with red logo.
- Red polo shirt (long or short sleeves) with green logo.
- Grey Trousers
- Grey socks with black shoes. (Black sports shoes with logos or inserted colours are not permitted)

Sports Uniform

Students may wear their sports uniform to school on their allocated physical education and sports days ONLY. If students do not have their FULL sports uniform then they are to wear ordinary school uniform (including school shoes) to school and change into their runners prior to sport.

All students are to have the following dress:

Footwear: Runners with non-marking soles

Winter: Black trackpants, red polo top, green windcheater, white anklet socks & runners.

Summer: Black basketball shorts, red polo top, white anklet socks & runners.

Uniform Regulations

Full School Uniform must be worn each day. If a child is at school not wearing full school uniform an explanatory note should be sent to school.

School hats must be worn by students when outside. A student who does not have a school hat must remain in a shaded area whilst outside.

Jewellery is not permitted (with the following exceptions)

- Watches
- “Golf” Bangles
- Earrings - only a single set of studs (not sleepers) may be worn in the earlobe.
- Single rubber promotional band

Nail Polish, thongs or sneakers are not to be worn to school.

Hair glitter is not permitted.

Long hair must be tied back.

- Hairclips must be kept simple and practical, and are not to be worn as a fashion statement.
- Hairclips are to be in school colours (red or green), white, or silver.
